Theological input

We believe that this course will provide you with a solid Biblical teaching that is practical and life-changing for your daily walk with Christ as well as growing you as in leadership. We don't just want students to simply get a theology degree. We want students to grow emotionally, physically & spiritually.

The 'Theological Input' would be in the form of sessions. Sessions are more like 'facilitated discussions' than strict/formal lectures

Facilitators will:

- Present the topic*
- Look at what the bible says on the topic*
- Encourage students to present their opinions on the topic*
- Focus on difficult or critical questions/teachings/aspects of chapters*
- Ensure that students get the 'just' of each chapter*
- Asses how students are doing, relating to their studies*

Service & outreach

We want to give students the opportunity to put to practise the skills and knowledge gained in lectures and impartation sessions through practical ministry and in their personal lives.

Students will be expected to be actively involved in some ministry in their local church. This may include serving at church on Sunday's, conferences and/or at various departments throughout the week.

Qualification

Students who successfully complete the course will receive a degree in theology (Bth). This degree will be completed through SATS, accredited by the Council on Higher Education and registered by the Department of Education.
